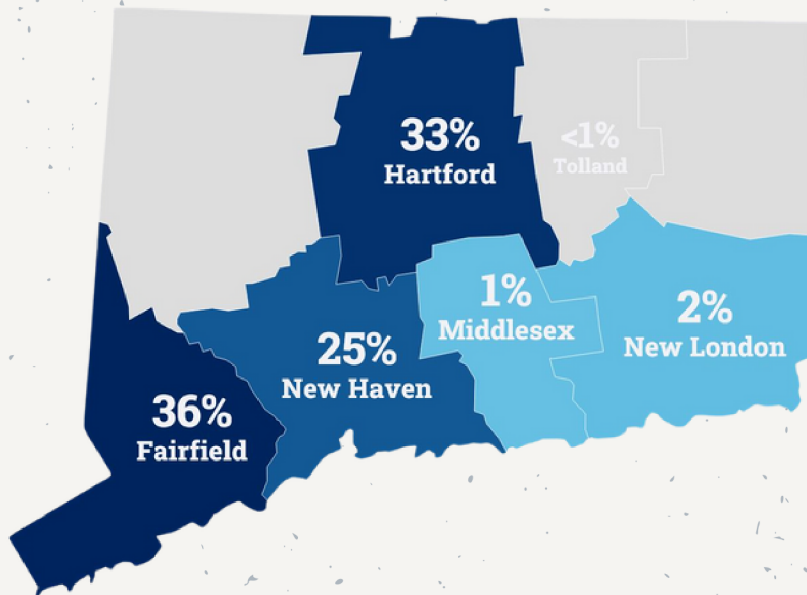


In 2023, CTData hosted **20** Workshops.
